Dear Friends,

Thank you for joining us at the WJCS 2021 Gala to celebrate tonight's honorees--Sarah Kayle and Suzi Randolph, two individuals who have had such an important impact on WJCS and, thereby, on the people of Westchester.

This has been a challenging and heart-wrenching year for many, due to the Covid pandemic. But WJCS never stopped delivering and expanding services. Wherever WJCS has seen a need, we have been there to respond. Our clients have needed emotional support more than ever before. We instantly pivoted last March to providing therapy via secure videochat and phone. To date, we have conducted almost 85,000+ telehealth sessions to our clients. When families from our mental health clinics and children, youth, and family programs needed food and diapers, we provided those. In response to the need for all students to have digital devices in an age of remote learning, WJCS launch the Digital Equity Program, providing Chromebooks, WIFI and mentoring to the youth in the WJCS Wiener Academy. The staff in our 13 group homes have worked tirelessly to keep residents safe and entertained at a time when they weren't able to see their families or go to their day programs. We've provided programming and services to seniors in our Yonkers NNORC, our Holocaust Survivors program, and in our geriatric care division—ensuring they have what they need and do not feel alone.

We're only able to achieve these accomplishments because of people like Sarah Kayle and Suzi Randolph, tonight's highly deserving honorees. Sarah and Suzi have channeled their hearts, minds, resources and hard work to help ensure that WJCS can fulfill its mission of serving the people of Westchester.

Sarah has been an active WJCS Board member since 2015. Her work with the Art Explorers club and Storybook Hour program have enriched the lives of so many children. Her years of dedication as Chair of our Program Services Committee, Gala Committee, Children Youth & Families Committee, and Volunteer Committee have been vitally important in helping WJCS fulfill and expand our mission and impact.

Suzi, as leader of the Wiener Philanthropy's efforts, has been instrumental in the creation and development of The Wiener Academy for Young Women, a WJCS after-school program that inspires and prepares girls ages 8-14 to succeed in school and life and achieve their potential. Suzi recognizes The Wiener Academy's life-changing potential and influence. And this is just one program of many that Wiener Philanthropies have supported at WJCS, including much-needed mental health initiatives.

MENTAL HEALTH

WJCS, the largest not-for-profit provider of licensed outpatient mental health services in Westchester, offers evidence-based treatment to thousands of individuals of all ages struggling with depression, anxiety, ADHD, and other mental health challenges.

TRAUMA

The renowned WJCS Trager Lemp Center for Treating Trauma & Promoting Resilience provides trauma treatment and resilience-building programs to adult and child survivors of sexual abuse and domestic and community violence as well as individuals who have suffered from other traumatic experiences.

INTELLECTUAL AND DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES

WJCS offers individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities, including those on the autism spectrum, social activities, skill-building classes, emotional support services, and community residences.

CHILDREN, YOUTH, AND FAMILIES

WJCS provides “cradle to college” programming, including early literacy, after-school enrichment and violence prevention and anti-bullying education.

OLDER ADULTS

WJCS geriatric services support older adults, allowing them to age safely and well in their homes and communities, whenever possible.

JEWISH COMMUNITY

WJCS is the 4-1-1 and 9-1-1 for the Westchester Jewish community. Jewish programming includes education, information, social activities, spiritual healing, and support to synagogues, day schools, nursery schools, assisted living centers, Holocaust survivors and their families, and to those needing help in a crisis.

Her involvement with WJCS started with volunteering for the Art Explorers club in the WJCS after-school enrichment program, a commitment that continues to this day. Sarah increased her involvement at WJCS by creating a Storybook Hour program for the school children, becoming Program Services Chair, and serving on the Gala Committee, the Children Youth & Families Committee, Volunteer Committee, and the WJCS Executive Committee.

A Marketing and Public Relations Specialist for many years, Suzi Randolph started a new career when she joined the Wiener Companies (now known as MAXX Properties) in 1990. She spent close to 20 years actively participating in the operations of the company and management of the company’s multi-family real estate assets. During that time, Suzi also advised and supported Robert Wiener, Chair of MAXX Properties, with his growing philanthropic endeavors. In 2008, as Robert Wiener’s philanthropy continued to expand, Suzi began to devote her work full-time to its development, overseeing programs and grants as well as building strong relationships with recipient organizations, both here in the United States and in Israel. In addition to leading MAXX’s and Robert’s philanthropic efforts, Suzi and her team also give counsel to the Wiener Family Future Foundation, the next-generation offspring of the Wiener Philanthropy.

Currently, the Wiener Philanthropy supports more than 60 non-profit organizations in the U.S. and Israel, focusing primarily on youth-at-risk and Zionist causes. The creation and development of The Wiener Academy, a WJCS after-school program for girls ages 8-14, and support of numerous WJCS mental health initiatives are at the forefront of the Wiener Philanthropy’s priorities.
